

A great base for Museum-going is near the Atocha rail station. From the many hotels there you can easily walk to the Prado, Reina Sofia, and Thyssen Museums. A quick metro ride from Atocha rail station will take you to the Museo Sorolla. Also from the Atocha station you can take the AVE train to Sevilla, or other destinations in Spain. Try to get a Free Shuttle from your hotel if they offer it, otherwise you can take the METRO from the Airport Terminal.

To Atocha from the Madrid-Barajas Airport:

Follow signs to the METRO. You will need to pay for your ticket at one of the machines and that will allow you to pass through the turnstiles. Save your ticket! Take the Metro #8 line to Nuevos Ministerios. Leave that train and head toward the Renfe/Cercanias train line in the same station. You will need to purchase another ticket and pass through more turnstiles. There are various lines that all stop at the Atocha station, such as the C-2 towards Guadalajara and the C-3 towards Aranjuez. Exit at the Atocha station, have a coffee and head up to the street!



From Atocha to the Sorolla Museum:

-Go down to the bottom floor to the METRO, (not the AVE or Renfe/Cercanias) a ticket will cost you 1Euro. Board the 'r' train towards 'Pinar de Chamartin', and get off at at the 'Iglesias' stop. Follow the signs to the exit at 'P. Gral. Mtnez. Campos'. The stairs will take you up to the road and you will walk straight ahead for 3 blocks. The Museum has a brick façade, next to the Bank of Santander.

-To return to Atocha get back on the same rail, #1, but head this time towards 'Valdecarros'. Get off at the Atocha stop.

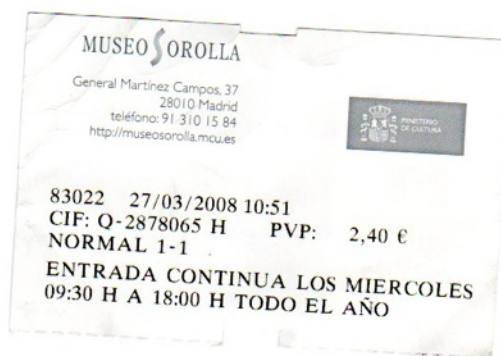
