The Jerez wineries, most famous for their Sherry and Manzanilla, are about 30 minutes from Arcos.

According to the 2008 Campsa guide to “The Best Wines in Spain” the following Jerez wineries are considered emblematic of Spain. Thirteen of the countries best wines came from these wineries, which were judged to be worthy of the ‘Wall of Honor of the Best Wines in Spain.’ All 29 award winning wines in the ‘Generosos Secos’ category came from Jerez. 10 of 20 award winning wines in the ‘Dulces’ category came from Jerez.
